Semester 2 Reports

Semester 2 Reports will be going home with all students on Monday 14th December 2020. These reports have returned to the usual format and will be graded for all Key Learning Areas. In NSW the A-E grading system is used and more information about grading is listed below. Most students will receive a C or a Sound grade. This means they are working at the expectation for their age and grade. Students need to show a sound understanding of content in order to achieve this grade.

A= Outstanding:

The student has an extensive knowledge and understanding of the content and can readily apply this knowledge. In addition, the student has achieved a very high level of competence in the processes and skills and can apply these skills to new situations.

B= High: The student has a thorough knowledge and understanding of the content and a high level of competence in the processes and skills. In addition, the student is able to apply this knowledge and these skills to most situations.

C= Sound: The student has a sound knowledge and understanding of the main areas of content and has achieved an adequate level of competence in the processes and skills.

D= Basic: The student has a basic knowledge and understanding of the content and has achieved a limited level of competence in the processes and skills.

E= Limited: The student has an elementary knowledge and understanding in few areas of the content and has achieved very limited competence in some of the processes and skills.

Effort is listed from most to least effort. A 5 indicates that a students is putting in the maximum amount of effort at all times and in all learning situations.

^{*}Essential parent and carer meetings with teachers and/or school executives.

^{*}Parents and carers who attend a school administration building or another defined location for the purpose of picking up their child if they are unwell or where they have been asked to arrange for a COVID-19 test after their child has displayed flu-like symptoms while at school.

^{*}Parents and carers who need to be on-site for canteen and uniform shop duties or to collect or purchase uniforms.

^{*}Parent or carer volunteers required as educational support roles for activities that are essential to the delivery of the curriculum, such as reding groups, music and kitchen garden areas. Schools are required to have scheduled programs in place and remind parents and carers that they must not attend school unless it has been previously arranged.

^{*}For specific end of year events as outlined in the guidelines to support planning activities for end-of-year events.


Planning for 2021

WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

- Children who live in NSW and who are in Kindergarten year 2, regardless of distance from school.
- Primary School Students who live in NSW and live greater than 1.6km from the school as the crow flies or walking distance is greater than 2.3km to the school.
- Secondary School Students who live in NSW and live greater than 2km from the school as the crow flies or walking distance is greater than 2.9km.

HOW TO APPLY.

- Please note that the link will not work on a phone.

CODE OF CONDUCT.

- When applying you will be required to tick a box that states you have read the code
 of conduct for your child. These rules should be read to your child, we follow these

 a suspension or termination of travel privileges.

UPDATED BUS STOP POLICY

 Baldwins Buses have implemented a new policy in regards setting children down on the roadside.
