Principal's Report Beach to Bush 2021

IPlay was a little different last week with Mrs Rourke donning a lifeguard uniform to help spread the word on beach and inland water safety. Finley Public School participated in "Beach to Bush", a Royal Life Saving funded program that brings the beach into classrooms all across Regional NSW. Students zoomed into presentations that were held live from Curl Curl Beach and learnt about general beach safety, rips and waves, basic first aid, rescues and getting help from a lifeguard. In the classroom, students learnt about dangers and hazards when swimming in rivers, lakes, channels and dams as well as sun safety.

At the conclusion of the lessons, each student received a Beach to Bush sticker and names were randomly drawn out to receive sponsored prizes and giveaways from Surf Lifesaving NSW




Finley High School are investigating the possibility of moving to online ordering for canteen orders in 2022. This service would be provided by QuickCliq.

OOSH provides fun, stimulating and safe care for primary school aged children as well as preschool aged children.

At OOSH the children have the opportunity to participate in cooking, sport, music, art, dance, personal interests, homework station and so much more.

The children from both the primary school's in Finley are collected via the bus with an educator from OOSH and delivered to Biralee.

Afternoon tea is prepared each afternoon for the children and is waiting for them when they get off the bus. A menu is prepared a week ahead and is on display for families.
